

REPORT TO THE CITY OF MISSION POLICE DEPARTMENT

Report to the City of Mission Police Department. No. 21-35585 (November 5, 2021)

I have been home-bound for more than ten years with a life-threatening Electrohypersensitivity (EHS), and Chemical Hypersensitivity (CHS) which are aggravated by exposure to even low levels of radiation and chemical odors.

Because of my EHS and CHS, I cannot stay in my home but for a few minutes at a time, and I stay in a metal room and on a mobile home, and in other places in the backyard.

My EHS and CHS have been recognized by federal and state agencies and by courts as a physical medical condition and as a disability.

The City of Mission Police Department has on its database medical, scientific and legal evidence of my EHS and CHS for emergency purposes and because I cannot be inside a hospital or any other building without suffering severe harm including death.

My life-threatening EHS and CHS require monitoring the levels of radiation with detection equipment. There have been increases of hot-spots of microwave and other radiation at my place. On October 30, 2021, a meter captured inside my mobile home in ten minutes about the same amount of ionizing radiation (X and Gamma rays) that occurs during an 8-hour period. The meter captured 16,100 Counts Per Minute. In ten minutes the average Counts Per Minute in this area in a ten minute count is less than 350 Counts Per Minute. An eight hour count in this area is about 16,000 Counts Per Minute. Two other meters placed about 50 and 60 feet away from the meter inside the mobile home did not capture increases in ionizing radiation.

I was in proximity to the meter inside the mobile home at the time the meter captured 16,100 Counts Per Minute during a ten minute period. I felt my head, heart and lungs like exploding and I was on the verge of collapse. I had to use oxygen on three nights.

On November 8, 2021, I attempted to make a complaint with the Federal Communications Commission, since the level of the hot-spots that at times reach my place indicate that whoever is transmitting this radiation is exposing people, including children to levels of radiation that can cause severe physical harm and even death.

In the past, in response to my complaints of flashes of microwave radiation at my place, a FCC Agent agreed that because the level of microwave radiation decreased exponentially with distance, the levels of microwave radiation captured by my meters indicates that the transmitters of this radiation was in violation of the federal safety limits and that even children could have been exposed to this harmful radiation.

On November 8, 2021, I attempted to make a complaint of the increased hot-spots of radiation at my place, Karen an FCC agent told me that to make a complaint, I had to first identify the source of radiation.

The same day I talked to Corporal Garces of the City of Mission Police Department who advised me that they could not use my detection equipment to identify the source of the radiation because they do not have equipment or the training to identify sources of radiation.

I am making this report to request the FCC to waive the requirements of identifying the offending transmitter and to make an investigation as accommodation to my disability.
